Study in the UK with Chevening

With a Chevening Scholarship, you'll have the opportunity to complete a one-year master's degree at the UK university of your choice.

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Who is Chevening for?

To be eligible to apply, you must:

- Be a citizen of one of 140+ Chevening-eligible countries and territories.
- Hold an undergraduate degree that qualifies you for a UK master's degree.
- Have acquired at least 2,800 hours (roughly equivalent to two years) of work experience after graduating from your undergraduate degree.
- Demonstrate outstanding future leadership potential.

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How to apply?

To apply for Chevening, you'll need to submit an online application form via the Chevening website, which includes responding to a series of essay-style questions.

Separately, you'll also need to apply to your three chosen UK university courses.
